




### Looking after a Child with a Bite or Sting

### LOOKING AFTER A CHILD WITH A BITE OR STING

### Bee Stings

Bees leave their stings in and die soon afterwards. You can remove the sting by flicking it with a blunt object.

The sting can also be removed with a pair of tweezers but this should be done carefully as the sting may inject the poison if squeezed.

Treatment - Mix Bicarbonate of Soda (Sodium Bicarbonate) with water to form a paste and apply to the affected area. Give Paracetamol to ease the pain.

### Wasp Stings

Wasps do not leave their stings in.

Treatment - Soak a swab in Vinegar and apply to the affected area. Give Paracetamol to ease the pain.

#### Animal Bites

Clean all bites thoroughly with any antiseptic you may have.

If the skin is broken then your child will need a particular antibiotic to prevent infection.

#### Mosquito Bites

Try not to let your child scratch the bites -Calamine Lotion should help - but do not use on broken skin. If the bites bleed, then clean them and cover with a plaster in order to help prevent infection. Give Paracetamol if painful.

It should not be necessary for you to bring your child to hospital with stings unless he/she develops a swelling of the neck or mouth or has difficulty in breathing.

# Is your child fully immunised against Tetanus?

By 6 months old your child should be immunised against Tetanus (and others) and again before starting school at approximately 5 years. This will provide Tetanus cover until the next booster which is due at approximately 15 years.

If it has been 10 years since the last Tetanus booster, then one will be required within 72 hours of receiving the bite. The Trust recognises the importance of multi agency working to safeguard children and young people.
