

Some colleagues raised more than one concern!

You said - We did ...

Policies and Procedures not being adhered to – Information reminders were sent out to teams affected by these concerns and an external HR Specialist was consulted and advice given acted upon to improve transparency in ALL job roles advertised.

Lack of Supervision for Junior Doctors – Meetings took place with the doctor raising the concerns and stakeholders, reassurances and support put in place and improvements made to address the concern.

Staffing levels in unscheduled care – Directorate Manager transferred staff from another ward to support the immediate shortages. The Trust's Board responded with information of proactive actions being put in place including Silver Command and the recruitment drive so colleagues not aware of what work the Trust was doing could be reassured their concerns were being acted upon.
