If you are thinking about a career in one of the health professions, work experience offers the chance to see what the job is really like. It may confirm your career choice, or open your eyes to other options that you haven't considered.

A record of work experience will be an advantage when you come to apply for jobs or higher education courses. If you have no particular career in mind, work experience in the NHS offers the opportunity to sample from a wide variety of jobs, across the whole range of interest and academic ability. It will teach you about teamwork, and help to develop a range of skills linked to your own personal development. Work experience will offer the opportunity to develop key functional skills within the context of work-based learning.

Students must have a postcode of FY1-8 or PR4. All students must be over the age of 14. (With the exception of the pre-med work experience programme – student must be 17 years of age)
