- Good track record of achieving key national standards & targets

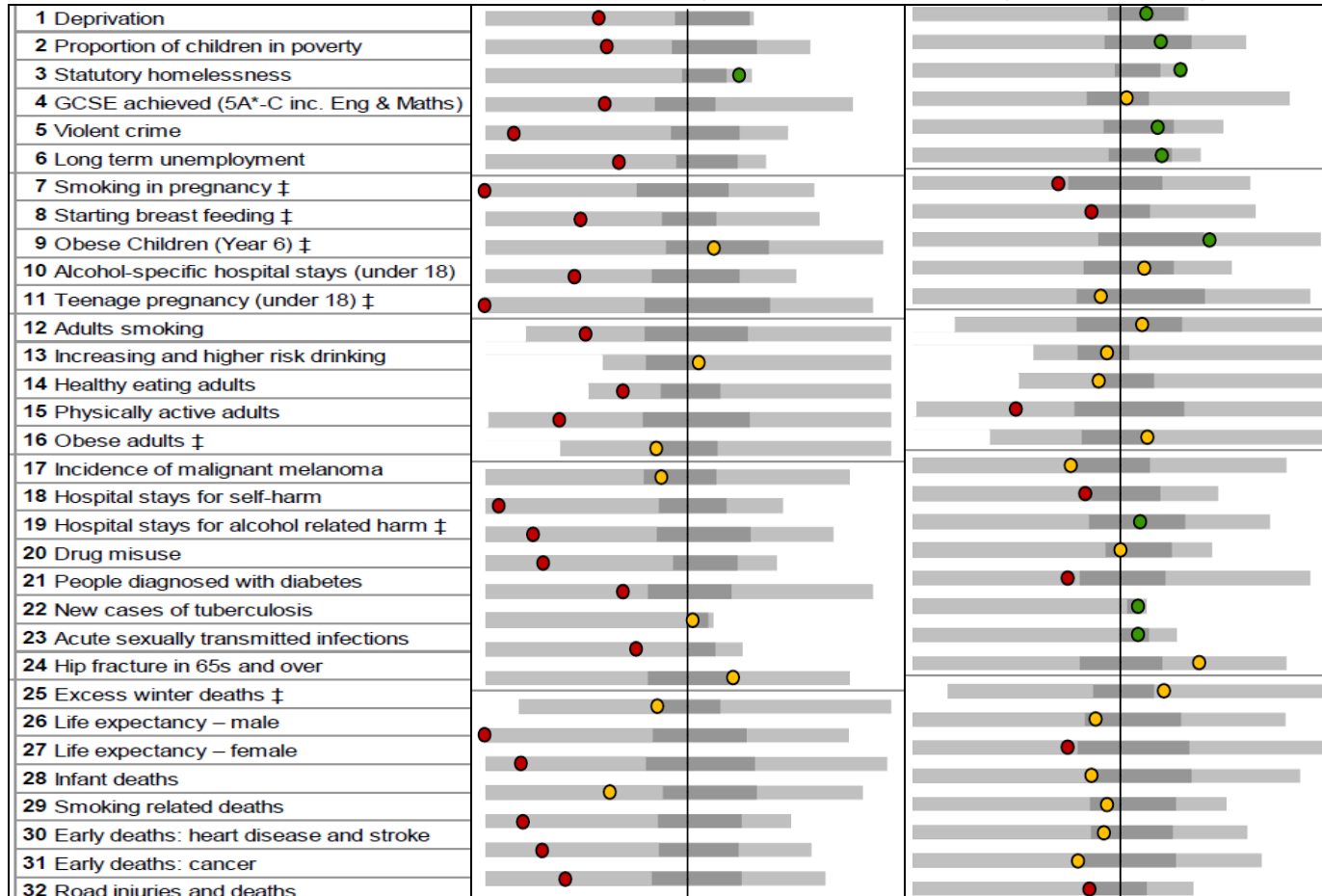
# Overview of the Trust
