What is the Neurodevelopment Pathway?

A way to help doctors and other health professionals understand your strengths and difficulties.

Why am I on it?

Your family and a professional who knows you, thinks you might need some extra support.

What will happen?

On the Pathway you will meet a consultant (type of doctor). You might also meet a Speech and Language Therapist.

These people will talk to you, your family and your school about the things you struggle with.

There will then be a meeting where the professionals will talk about your strengths and difficulties and how they can help you.

Who can I talk to?

You can ask the Pathway Team any questions you have.

You could also talk to your teacher or the SENCO in your school.

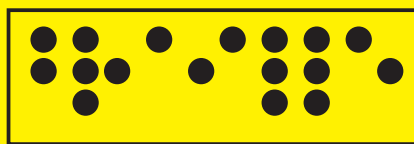
