<p>Do you provide free parking for NHS staff and/or patients?</p>	<p>Yes we provide free parking for staff as follows;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hold a blue badge • Work permanent nights
<p>If not, how much do you charge staff to park?</p>	<p>Staff who hold a parking permit pay monthly parking charges according to their pay bandings as follows;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Band 1/2 - £10 • Bands 3/4 - £15 • Bands 5/7 - £20 • Band 8 - £25 • Band 9 & equivalent - £30 <p>Part time staff working 20 hours or less are charged at 50% of the above charge</p>
<p>How long does it take for staff to be issued a permit when joining your trust?</p>	<p>There is currently a waiting list for staff parking permits. The waiting time varies as allocation depends on a number of criteria. Generally speaking, staff who work rotational shifts, who have childcare and travel some distance will be appointed a permit before those staff working core hours.</p>
